PITCH VIDEO EVALUATION & FEEDBACK

Pitch Competition Criteria (scale of 1 to 10; 1 = low, 10 = high)

- Description of their Remarkable Idea to Reimagine their Community
- Was the idea conceived of, owned, and presented by a woman or team of women?
- Did the pitch presenter answer these 3 questions?
 1. Why now?
 2. Why this?
 3. Why me?
- Overall quality of the pitch video
